Sponsorship

A weekly program Sponsorship is an easy way to let listeners know that you believe in giving back to the community.

Four times during the program, the show host will announce your business name, your contact information, location, and give a brief description of what you do.

The host will also include your name on the show's randomly played promotional spot.

Your business name will be listed as the sponsor in the program's description on our website, and linked to your webpage.

Your logo will be included on our sponsor sign which is displayed at our fundraisers and events we attend.

Sponsorship of a once a week, one hour program is only \$100.00 a month plus gst.

If the program repeats during the same week, all your sponsor messages will be included at no extra charge.

Affordable Advertising

All 30 second ad spots are only \$6.00 each.

You may write the spot, or we'll write it for you with information you provide. You may voice the spot, or we'll voice the spot for you.

We require a minimum order of 5 spots to start, with a set-up fee to cover production costs.

Initial 5 spots plus set up: \$55 plus gst. Additional spots: \$6 each plus gst.

Charities and non-profits receive a discount.


