The purposes of the Society are:

- (a) provide public community radio broadcasts through existing and future technologies;
- (b) create a medium for balanced expression of the varied perspectives of our community;
- (c) educate, entertain and inform our community through traditional and innovative broadcast journalism and high quality programming;
- (d) provide a diverse and multicultural experience to our listeners, reflecting the background and knowledge of our community:
- (e) share technology and programming with other community radio stations;
- (f) train community radio society volunteers and staff in effective broadcasting skills:
- (g) acquire land, buildings, equipment and expertise to broadcast appropriately and effectively;
- (h) raise funds in such manner and to such extent as the Society deems necessary or desirable to carry out its purposes, including, without limitation, soliciting and accepting gifts, contributions, donations, bequests and other grants of real and personal property and services;
- (i) hold, invest, expend, use and deal with the funds it has raised and otherwise received for the carrying out of the Society's purposes as the Board of Directors sees fit;
- (j) borrow, raise and secure the payment of funds in such manner as the Society sees fit for the carrying out of the Society's purposes;
- (k) enter into contracts, leases, subleases and other arrangements and do all such other things as are necessary and conducive to the carrying out of the Society's purposes;
- (I) apply for and maintain all such licenses, permits and insurance as may be necessary or advisable for the carrying out of the Society's purposes;
- (m) enter into arrangements with any federal, provincial, municipal and/or local government or authority that may be necessary or conducive to the carrying out of the Society's purposes and to obtain from any such government or authority any rights, grants, funding, loans, privileges, leases, subleases, or concessions which the Society sees fit;
- (n) hire and pay any person(s), firm(s) and or corporation(s) for services rendered in connection with the conduct of the Society's operations and the carrying out of the Society's purposes; and
- (o) cooperate with and, if the Society sees fit, assist any other society, association, person or entity where the intended result is to further the Society's purposes.
